

Planning Board Members Present: Albert Hislop, Denis Hebert, John Frink, Jack Pare, Barbara Hill, Chris Cross, Bob Simms, and Cos Iocovozzi

Minutes of September 9: Hill moved to approve; Frink seconded. Pare noted that the Sprague walk was scheduled for the 14th, and that Lamson did not vote. Hebert inquired about swimming pools. Cross added "*for reasons of highway safety*" to page one under correspondence. Hislop called for a vote. All voted in favor of adopting the minutes as amended, except Cross who voted no. Hebert abstained because he had not been present.

Correspondence: Cross & Hebert discussed a request by Great Bay Services for a crosswalk across Woodbury Avenue. Hebert moved to direct the Town Planner to write to NH DOT recommending a crosswalk. Hill seconded. All in favor.

Hebert & Cross spoke to the letter from ConEdison regarding the paving schedule.

Pare asked about the Selectmen's letter to Howard Patten. Cos updated the board on the status of that matter. Hislop complimented the Selectmen regarding their approach to this issue.

Master Plan: Board reviewed Morgan's draft of the Citizen Survey. Some minor changes were made. Cross moved to direct Morgan to format the questionnaire and to mail it to townspeople. Simms seconded the motion. All in favor.

Lordco: Hislop announced that the hearing would be continued to Nov. 11 at 7PM.

Public Hearing on Storage Trailers: The Building Inspector spoke to the proposed zoning amendment. Cross distributed an alternative amendment. Frink declared that he would vote against both versions. The board agreed that residential zones would be excluded from this amendment's jurisdiction. Iocovozzi moved to continue the public hearing to November 11. Hill seconded. All in favor. Hislop announced the continuance to November 11 at 7PM. Frink indicated that he had reconsidered his opposition.
