The meeting was called to order by Chairman Iocovozzi at 5:59pm on July 18.

Present: Chairman Cosmas Iocovozzi, Selectman Jan Stuart, Selectman Jack O'Reilly, Administrative Assistant Beatrice Marconi, Building Inspector Charles Smart and Chief of Police Jon Tretter.

Selectman Stuart moved for the meeting to go into non-public session under RSA 91-A:3, II (a & e) Personnel/Legal. Seconded by Selectman O'Reilly. ***Motion passed 3-0 with a roll call vote.***

The Board of Selectmen apologized to Mr. Smart who then in turn apologized to the Board and the people of Newington for losing his cool.

Chief Tretter said that the incident occurring at Old Town Hall on July 13 - Barbara McDonald's claim with the Police Department the following day was determined to be unfounded after completion of the Chief's investigation and interviews with various witnesses.

Discussion continued about 'hostile environment', 'workplace stress level', restricting those individuals who consume staff time beyond normal limits, and requests that come in should go through the Board, rather than the staff spending precious work time on pet projects for individuals.

Selectman Stuart stated that the Board held no ill feelings towards Mr. Smart.

Jan Stuart made the motion to come out of non-public at 6:26. Seconded by Jack O'Reilly, on a roll call vote ***motion carried 3-0.***

In the public portion of the meeting, Selectman Jan Stuart made the motion to **seal** the non-public session minutes. Selectman O'Reilly seconded. ***Motion passed 3-0.***
