Selectman O'Reilly made the motion to accept the minutes of July 6, 2004. Seconded by Selectman Iocovozzi. Vote 2-0.

The Selectmen reviewed and accepted the Treasurer's report for May 2004.

A motion to accept and sign the release was made by Selectman O'Reilly. Seconded by Selectman Iocovozzi. Vote 2-0.

Tax Collector W.J. Mazeau requested the addition of Richard Elliott and John Melecio to the Resident Tax list. Motion to approve the additions made by Selectman O'Reilly. Seconded by Selectman Iocovozzi. Vote 2-0.
