

## Newington School Board's Plan for Tuitioning Students into Newington

- Rationale for Continuing the Study:
  - Following through with our pledge to search for avenues to lower costs per resolutions after June '06 Public Forum.
  
- SAU Responsibilities:
  - Follow through with study & action items below with completion date of April 2008
  - Develop a timeline with decision points and keep school board on track until completion. Revise completion date if necessary.
  - Continue to inform the Newington community with a minimum of biannual updates, provide board with quarterly updates.
  
- Study and Action Items:
  - Tuitioning in of Parentally Placed Students; this option is presently deemed on hold by the board for one year (April 2008) due to recent legal changes. At that time the SAU board should decide further study or to discontinue study of this option based on SAU Superintendent's recommendation.
  - Tuitioning in of Other School District's Students; Study should include:
    - Marketing plan – which incorporate how we would communicate the sale of our services to other districts (i.e. – via internet, newsletter, etc.)
    - Recommended Policy on the acceptance and dismissal of students to include special services students or the discovery of the need for special services after students are admitted.
    - Legal review of the two items listed above including any others, which need it prior to students being contracted in.
    - Establishing tuition formula for incoming students (via) Board or Community Panel
