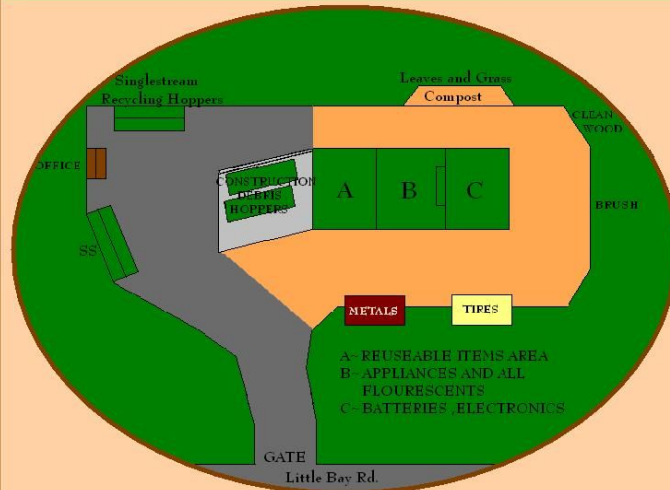


# Newington Transfer Station

## Singlestream Recycling

Singlestream recycling is a new and more convenient way to recycle most all your plastic metal and glass containers and most all paper and cardboard materials. Its a single hopper operation without separation of materials. Please follow guidelines on hoppers for item acceptability.

## Compost area

This area is for the decomposition of grass, leaves, and light garden clippings (no evergreens), for use in spring to richen soils for gardening etc.

## Clean Wood

We accept any clean wood trimmings, posts, plywoods, planks etc. Any particle board, oriented strand board, pressure treated or painted /stained wood will be accepted in the Demolition Hoppers.

## Brush

We accept all types of brush, branches, light stumps, logs (8' max). Any hardwood logs will be kept to right for reuse.

## Tires

Any rubber vehicle tires accepted here.

## Metals

Any primarily metal materials deposited here. Lawn chairs, metal office chairs, grilles, ductwork, metal siding, empty paint cans, auto parts. Any power equipment must be drained of all oils and fuels before deposition.

## Construction Debris (Landfill hoppers)

Debris from any home renovation or attic and garage debris, wood windows, wallboard, tile, carpeting, vinyl siding, garden hose, non recyclable plastics, and any general clean-up waste. All Latex Paints will be accepted DRY or Jelled. All Oil based paints and stains are considered Hazardous Waste and are not accepted at this facility along with. Any fuels, pesticides, insecticides fungicides or any chemicals which can be saved for deposition at the Portsmouth DPW Facility on Pevery Rd. during their bi-annual hazardous waste collection days. Household kitchen garbage for pick-up wednsdays.

## Area A

This area is reserved for any reuseable items (furniture, antiques, etc.) and is available during all hours of operation for your browsing needs!

## Area B

This area is for any old washers, dryers, stoves, air conditioners and refridgerators. There is also a recepticle for all CFL's and flourescent tubes.

## Area C

Here we accept all lead acid batteries (automotive and marine) and any rechargeable type battery (nickel cadmium and nickel metal hydride). All other general use batteries can be deposited in landfill hoppers or thrown away with regular garbage as they are not considered hazardous waste. We also accept all televisions, computers, monitors and electronics.

We welcome you to come visit your facility and help take part in our important mission to REDUCE hazardous environmental impact, REUSE materials for longer life, and RECYCLE any materials that may have otherwise been thrown away.
