Discussion & Decision
Ron reviewed key elements of the approved design, which is 800 sq. ft. less than originally planned on. The design is very lean and all public spaces are as small as possible according to code. The adult collection bookshelves will be 7 shelves high, as opposed to the traditional 5 shelves high, to save on floor space. The kid's bookshelves will be 4 or 5 high as opposed to 3, for the same purpose.
Ron displayed and/discussed design options that would be the most cost efficient and esthetically pleasing, both interiorly and exteriorly. Last week, we discussed "themes" of the building considering cost, historical perspective, and coordination with the architecture in the rest of the town. One idea that was discussed was a "barn theme", which would pay homage to the heritage of this town. Discussed cement board versus brick. The cost of brick would be significantly higher, and the ability to match the brick and mortar would be impossible (which would then clash/compete with existing brick). Ceiling would be high and flat to lower heating/cooling and construction costs, and to reduce acoustic hollowness.
Discussed items that should be presented at the public meeting on Saturday. Will review issues with existing building that need to be repaired. Will discuss how we came to the design came to fruition. Will highlight lean design elements, size, needs, etc. Will map out the largest space in the library to demonstrate sizes. Ron will create a PP for us to review by the end of the week.
Scott had contacted several companies last week to evaluate the items in the attic- the Athenaeum is coming on Thursday to evaluate. Scott measured the shelving in the attic, which equals 300 linear feet. The remainder of the library has 1000 linear feet of shelving. The new building would host 2000 linear feet of shelving.
