1. Director's Report

- Director booking Summer Reading Programs - trustees approved expenditures/nominal donations of \$50 or less to cover mileage and/or materials, as needed.

2. Director reports that Sony is offering libraries a special program for their E-Reader. Scott will apply for this free E-Reader.

3. Trustees asked the Director to purchase, in addition to the Nook currently owned by the library, a Kindle and a Color Nook. This will allow the Director and staff to become familiar with both types so as to better help the patrons who are now coming in on a regular basis looking for help with their e-readers. This also increases our e-reader inventory, which will encourage increased patron use and familiarity, and additionally, facilitate use of the State's e-book lending program.

4. Trustees asked the Director to select three or four Library consultants from the provided spreadsheet, ask them to submit proposals, which need to be available for the Trustees before their next meeting in two weeks.
