Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, December 18, 2018 Town Hall

Fabyan Point Road Status:

E. Weinrieb reviewed the conditions of approval listed in the Fabyan Point Development Agreement.

B. Johnson stated that the sign at Kennard Pond has been moved to a better location. E. Weinrieb reviewed the required storm water pollution prevention plan reports.

The siting of the ditch and electrical box in front of the Savinelli's home was discussed.

Discussion ensued about the eventual acceptance of the road and what needed to be accomplished before this happened.

B. Johnson was told that he needed to come back before the Planning Board if he had any concerns or problems fulfilling the Development Agreement conditions.

T. Connors asked how the project can be moved along. E. Weinrieb stated that before the paving starts he wants to be notified so that he can inspect the subbase conditions. Altus Engineering will send a letter of recommendation to the Planning Board once they are satisfied.

Discussion was held about rain gardens.

D. Hebert expressed concern that the developer is approaching the Selectmen rather than the Planning Board about the road acceptance.

The Board of Selectmen recessed the meeting at 10:30am

The Board reconvened the meeting at 10:36am

Fire Dept Overtime Payouts:

K. Latchaw expressed concern about the overtime payments in the Fire Dept. Several managerial staff are out resulting in overtime of one office being required.

Transfer Station Recycling Hopper Supervision:

The Board instructed M. Roy to write a letter to the Transfer Station Superintendent about stepped up supervision of the recycling hopper due to garbage being placed in it.

Adjournment: M. Marconi moved to adjourn at 11:00am. This was seconded by K. Latchaw with all in favor.
