New Business

- Planner Morgan discussed the Eversource Seacoast [Power] Reliability Project (SRP)
 - Town was contacted about 2 years ago
 - Plan to run power lines about 100 feet tall using existing right of way
 - Crossing through National Register District at the Frink Farm
 - Section 106 applies to this case
 - Recommendations
 - Request Consulting Party status under Section 106
 - Speak with SHPO (NHDHR) - E. Feighner
 - Coordinate with Selectmen and Planning Board
 - PB has hired attorney Susan Geigner for this project
 - Contact State and national senators and representatives
 - Extension of Shattuck Way will require wetland mitigation - under discussion
- Motion: (J.Lamson moved, P.Pelletier 2nd) that the town request Consulting Party status in the SRP under the Section 106 review process. Approved: unanimous
 - J.Lamson will request the Selectmen to be on BOS next agenda, May 18
 - G.Pare to contact NHDHR, Edna Feighner and S.Geigner for assistance
- T.Morgan informed HDC that the Mary Yeaton house on Patterson Lane is under threat of demolition
 - C.Gunn will contact K.Frizzell for permission to document the house
 - G.Pare to seek architectural historian to conduct informal survey
 - Note: a Yeaton was the first Commandant of the US Coast Guard
 - Note: the small out building was a railroad station moved to this property

Old Business -

- Historic District Sign
 - Still need approval from Selectmen
 - Not current priority; develop 2015 project - individual building signs
- CLG 2014 - 15 Grant
 - UNH map digitizing progress almost complete
 - Historian - must contract this work
- CLG 2015 -16 application deadline passed - 4/27
- Next HDC meeting 5/18 - 3:30 to prepare for BOS meeting that evening
