A brief site walk to the Langdon Library was conducted

- Observed the foundation as poured - spoke to Marty about the coloring

The Minutes of July 31, 2013 were approved

Old Business -

- Library addition
 - J.Lamson moved (P.Pelletier 2nd) Because the cement can be colored at any time, the HDC will make a final decision on the color of the foundation once the siding is in place. Passed unanimous
 - J.Lamson moved (P.Pelletier 2nd) to approve the wood grain textured all gray siding with added battens for the sides and back of the Library addition. Passed unanimous
 - E.D'Orto moved (P.Pelletier 2nd) to approve the proposed outside lighting units #809. Passed unanimous
- Tricentennial plan for Sunday, September 15
 - Monument rededication at 11:00 am
 - Include NHINAC flag bearers (from the Pow Wow)
 - Music from Ancient Order of Hibernians Pipe Band (Military set)
 - Place the Other Veterans Plaque on a stand - ask for more names
 - Parade from Monuments back to Pow Wow, behind the Old Town Hall, for Grand Entry

- Sign proposed by Library Trustees
 - P.Pelletier moved (E.D'Orto 2nd) to approve the concept of placing a sign similar to the new sign in front of the Town Hall at the corner of Nimble Hill and Little Bay roads subject to a final review of the design and placement. Passed unanimous
