- Current expenditures were discussed. D will meet with our Treasure, L and Director soon to provide a line-by-line overview of the budget
- The Director is doing a good job of controlling expenses. The budget is tight.
- D checks all budgeted lines vs. spending

**Personnel**: Moved by S and seconded by L to accept The Director's recommendation for personnel remuneration. Approved 4-0

**Training**: It is recognized that per the Personnel Policy the Director may authorize training up to \$500. Staff cross-training is ongoing.

**Inter Library Loan**: Moved by L, seconded by P to authorize the Director to recommend a new ILL pick-up/drop-off location. Approved 4-0

**Building Issues**: The following were discussed:

• Lawn burned areas need to be addressed. Water is being connected for the sprinkler system (see vote below). J recommended we look into some kind of pavers along the sidewalks where salt ruins the grass.

- Due to winter ice problems, the handicap parking spot may have to be moved
- The heating fuel price for the current year needs to be checked vs the town's supplier
- Extra mosquito spraying on movie nights will be needed. S will check with the town hall.
- There may be some flashing repairs needed. Will be looked into.
- The contracted cleaning company is working out well

Moved by P and seconded by L to authorize the expenditure of up to \$1200 for the work and materials necessary to reconnect the sprinkler system and to request reimbursement from the town for the work done for the cemetery portion. Approved 4-0
