

Maple Sap Questionnaire

The U.S. Air Force is assessing Maple Tree tapping to understand whether syringing is a local activity and where it's occurring, as part of the Remedial Investigation at Pease Air Force Base. To collect this information, the Air Force's contractor, Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions (Wood), is conducting a questionnaire. Anyone who routinely taps trees for sap collection and consumption in the vicinity of Pease Air Force Base (primarily Newington) is encouraged to complete this questionnaire.

Participation in this data collection effort is voluntary. Information provided will be helpful in identifying if impacts from Pease are possible.
