

## PUBLIC MEETING

The Pease Development Authority will be hosting a Local Concerns Meeting for the New Hampshire Avenue/Pease Boulevard/Arboretum Drive Intersection Improvement Project on February 15, 2023 at 1:00 p.m. at the offices of the Pease Development Authority, 55 International Drive, Portsmouth, NH 03801.

The project seeks to improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion at the intersection of the referenced streets by constructing a right turn lane on New Hampshire Avenue. The project is funded through the federal Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality program and is administered by NHDOT. The federal grant funding covers 80% of costs with the Pease Development Authority providing a matching 20%.

The purpose of the Local Concerns Meeting is to allow members of the public:

- To hear the general overview of the program funding requirements;
- To find out the proposed schedule of the project;
- To obtain an overview of the PDA's and our consultant's understanding of the project area and potential issues to be addressed/overcome;
- To provide comments on the proposed project.

The meeting will feature a presentation by PDA's consultant, Vanasse, Hangen and Brustlin, followed by a comment period by the public.
